Please note

- 1. Do not enter the Museum if you have a fever, cough, or other symptoms of illness.
- 2. Wear a mask during your visit.
- 3. Visitors are subject to a temperature screening upon entry.

 Anyone with a temperature of 99.5°F or higher will not be allowed in the Museum.
- 4. Sanitize your hands prior to viewing the exhibitions using the alcohol spray provided or by washing them with soap and water in a restroom.
- 5. Please keep a distance from other visitors of at least 2 meters.
- 6. Keep conversation to a minimum when inside the exhibition galleries. Do not to touch the exhibition objects, cases, equipment, or walls.
- 7. Reduced the number of seats in the lounge.
- 8. Resumed some woodworking room events, but they must be applicated in advance.
